

Learnership 2021 Advert

Applications are invited from unemployed individuals who are interested in completing a Further Education and Training Certificate: Nature Conservation: Natural Resource Guardianship Terrestrial (NQF 4) Learnership and is willing to partake in outdoor practical work in nature. The successful applicant will be based on a Nature Reserve. The successful applicant will receive a stipend of R3500 per month.

Responsibilities include

- Assisting in the conservation of biodiversity on the reserves and conservation areas
- Monitoring and removal of invasive vegetation,
- Assist with tasks such as fires, rehabilitation and restoration, infrastructure maintenance, monitoring fauna and flora, plant propagation and administration
- Collection of data in order to best achieve the objectives.
- Interacting with community members, residents, business owners and organisations to promote environmental education and awareness of and involvement in the reserve
- Complete assignments timeously and in relation to practical experience on the reserves
- Attend training and learner support sessions

Requirements

- In possession of a Grade 12/matric certificate
- Be unemployed and between the ages of 18 – 30 years
- Are South African Citizens with a valid ID identification card/book
- Are willing to commit to a full-time programme for a 12-month period
- Are in possession of a bank account in their own name
- Must be interested in completing a nature conservation qualification.
- Are able to spend 5 weeks away from Cape Town on accredited training
- Must be willing to undergo training and complete related assignments
- At least six months' experience in a nature conservation role would similar role would be advantageous
- Must have own accommodation in Cape Town Metro
- Preference will be given to applicants with a valid driver's licence
- Must be interested in working outdoors and doing practical work
